Day 1: Arrive Anchorage

Welcome to Alaska! Arrive into

Anchorage, Alaska largest city located between the Chugach Mountains and the Cook Inlet. Meet your Tour Director and transfer to your hotel.

Overnight: Anchorage

Day 2: Anchorage - Rail Journey - Denali National Park

This morning transfer to the Anchorage Rail Depot where you will board a **Deluxe Dome Rail-car** for full day scenic rail journey north to **Denali National Park**. Sit back, relax and enjoy breakfast on board this picturesque train ride as your train guide provide expert commentary. View magnificent panoramas along the route, including the Susitna River, the longest in South Central Alaska, with its premier streams sometimes plentiful with salmon and rainbow trout. 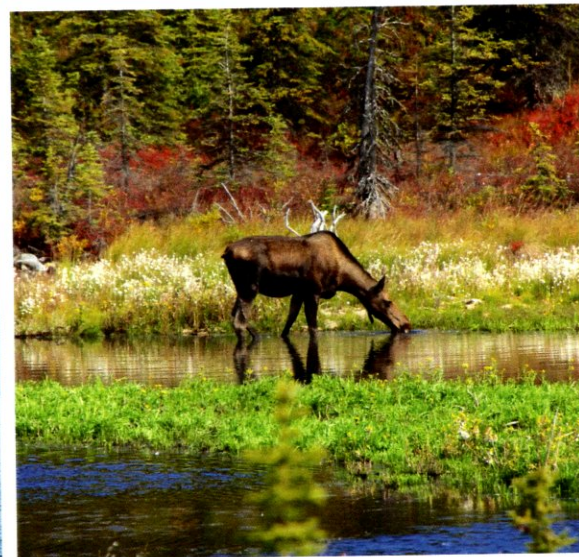
explore this pristine area at your leisure or join an optional tour.

The Seward Highway hugs the dramatic shorelines of Turnagain Arm, arguably one of the most beautiful stretches of highway in America. Each turn reveals another scenic wonder. Keep an eye out for Dall sheep up high in the cliffs along with moose, bear and eagles along the way. Later arrive in Seward and unpack for a three night stay.

Day 5: Seward - Glacier & Wildlife Cruise

Following breakfast, board a **Glacier and Wildlife Cruise** and travel through the majestic **Kenai Fjords National Park**. Explore the face of a glacier and keep your eyes open for seals, sea lions, sea otters, whales, bears, eagles, and puffins throughout this half-day exploration cruise. Lunch is included on board. Return to the harbor for an evening at leisure and dinner on your own.
